ORDER TO SEAL PER FS 943.059/FLA. R. CRIM. PROC. 3.692

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on a petition to seal/expunge certain records concerning petitioner's arrest or notice to appear/sworn complaint issued on _____ by _____ (agency name), and the Court having heard argument of counsel and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, the Court finds:

1. The petitioner has never previously been adjudicated guilty of a criminal offense or a comparable ordinance violation nor adjudicated delinquent for committing a felony or a misdemeanor specified in section 943.051(3)(b), Florida Statute.
2. The petitioner was not adjudicated guilty of nor adjudicated delinquent for committing any of the acts stemming from the arrest or criminal activity to which the instant petition pertains.
3. The petitioner has not secured a prior records expunction or sealing.
4. A Certificate of Eligibility issued by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement accompanied the instant petition for sealing nonjudicial criminal history records.
5. The petitioner has or has not requested that documents recorded in Official Records be removed (any monetary sums shown on any recorded documents are paid or the persons who were to receive those monetary sums were noticed of this request and have not objected). Whereupon, it is

ORDERED that the petition to seal is granted. All court records pertaining to this case shall be sealed in accordance with the procedures set forth in Florida Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.692, including any documents identified in the petition as being recorded in Official Records, upon payment of all associated costs to the clerk. This order shall go into effect 60 days from the date it is signed; and it is further and it is further

ORDERED that the clerk of this court shall forward a certified copy of this order to the prosecuting agency (check one) state attorney, _____ (agency), and the Sheriff of Alachua County, who will comply with the procedures in §943.059, Fla. Stat., and appropriate regulations of the Department of Law Enforcement and who will further forward a copy of this order to any agency that their records reflect has received the instant criminal history record information; and it is further

ORDERED that _____ (agency) shall seal all information concerning indicia of arrest or criminal history record information regarding the arrest or alleged criminal activity to which this petition pertains in accordance with the procedures set forth in §943.059, Fla. Stat., and Florida Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.692.

All costs of certified copies are to be borne by the Petitioner.

ORDERED that the petitioner has or has not requested that the documents recorded at book _____ page _____ or instrument number _____ be removed from the Official Record and such request, if made, is granted and the Clerk is directed to remove the identified documents from the Official Record as authorized in section 28.222(4), Florida Statutes.
