

The flyer alerts Alachua County residents and businesses that a **LEVEL 1 WATER SHORTAGE** has been declared for all of Alachua County. It asks them to take the following recommended actions:

1. Turn Off Irrigation Systems

With cooler temperatures, landscapes naturally go dormant. Continued irrigation can increase vulnerability to pests and disease. Irrigation systems should remain off and only be operated manually if absolutely necessary. Check systems carefully for leaks.

2. Postpone New Landscaping

Newly planted landscapes require significant water for establishment. Please delay planting until water conditions improve.

3. Avoid Water-Intensive Activities

Postpone pressure washing, vehicle washing, and other non-essential outdoor water uses.

4. Report Water Waste
